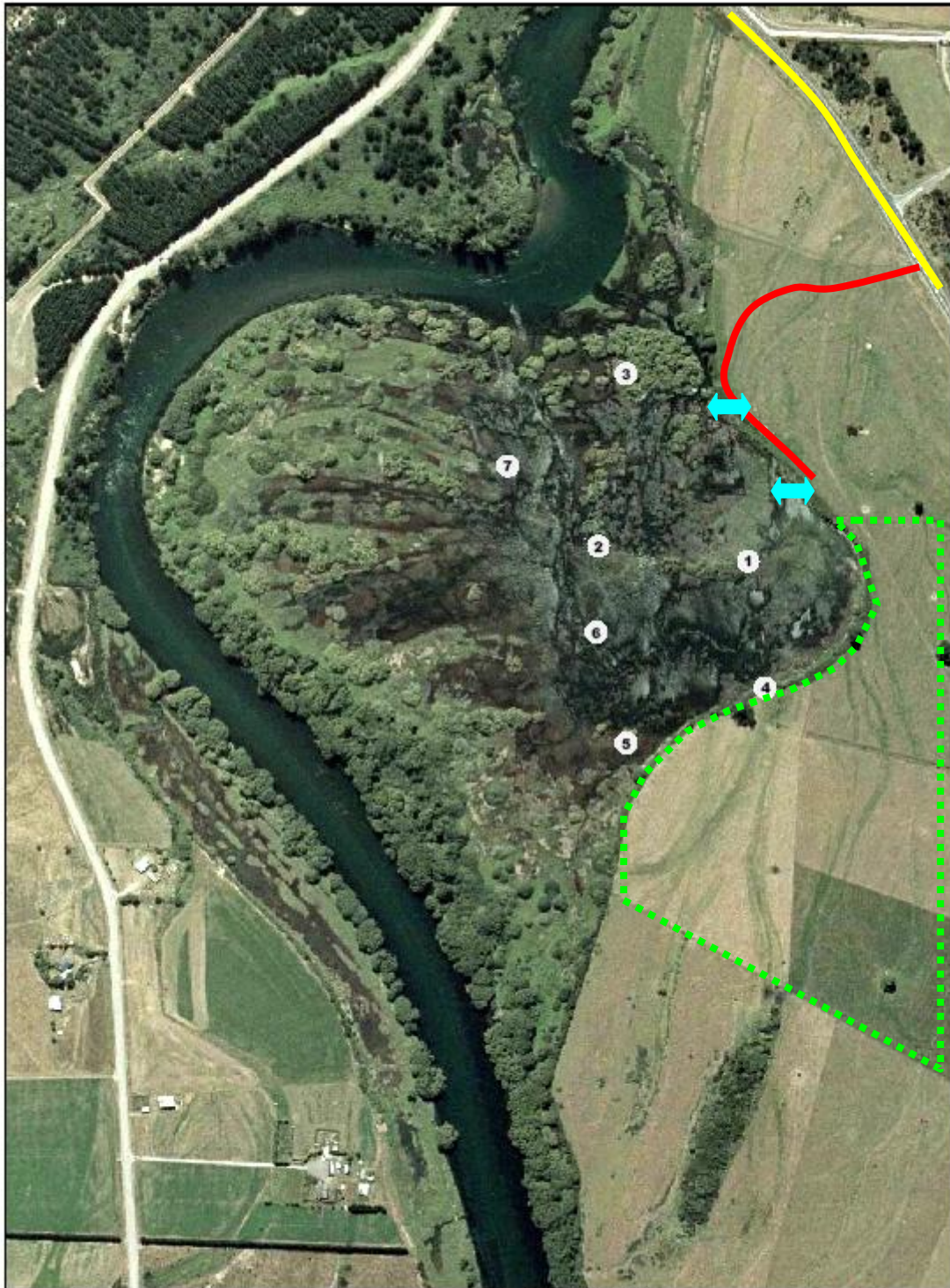




RAWHITI – access is via a Landcorp farm off Ohaaki Bridge Road. The access point is F&G sign posted and on the South Western side (true right) of the Waikato River. Travel through the paddock to the edge of the lagoon where two alternative boat and person styles are located. Contact with the farm manager is compulsory prior to access permission granted, as a hazard acknowledgment form must be signed. A boat is required to access all maimais. Access may also occur via the Waikato River should you launch your boat at other sites.
